We are handing over to you a short leaflet on how to take care of your equipment. Remember that the products you have purchased are made of natural materials such as wood, genuine leather and stainless steel or bronze.

By taking care of your equipment, you will contribute to extending its usefulness, functionality and safety in use.



Leather

CHARACTERISTICS

Leather is a natural material quality of which depends, in part, upon the animals themselves – specifically, their breed, geographical origin, climate, age and gender.

Leather is especially robust and durable. Its beauty evolves with use, so that leather acquires its typical patina as the years go by.

Everyone who is familiar with and enjoys natural leather is aware of its individual characteristics. Because leather from different skins is used in a single product, there are minimal variations in its grain and texture. Body warmth and physical weight can cause the leather to stretch under intensive use, making the surface slightly wavy. When a product is smoothed, the surface returns to its original form; later, it acquires the natural patina so appreciated by leather enthusiasts: Leather ages naturally. New leather equipment sometimes still carries a trace odour from the production process, yet this quickly dissipates after a short period of use.


HOW TO CARE FOR LEATHER?











Make sure that your leather equipment is not positioned close to heat sources, so that it does not dry out and become brittle. In addition, we recommend that leather surfaces are not permanently exposed to intense sunlight, because direct sunlight over an extended time period can diminish the quality of the leather.

In the case of genuine leather, small irregularities are a mark of its origin and naturalness. Its quality is in no way diminished by such variations. PENT. has a very strict selection process: only the best skins are used.

HOW DOES THE LEATHER HOLD UP TO SWEAT?

Treat your leather equipment with the appropriate products as soon as you acquire them, clean and treat them regularly to keep them sweat- and oil-stain free.

If your leather equipment already has sweat or oil stains on it, clean it with the leather cleaner product recommended by its manufacturer; follow the cleaning product manufacturer's instructions for application. After cleaning your leather furniture item treat it with leather protection cream. Leather cream coats the furniture and prevents sweat and oil from seeping through.

Clean your leather furniture and apply protection cream around four times a year.





CHARACTERISTICS

Stainless steel fitness equipment is made of a steel alloy that contains chromium. The good thing about stainless steel is that it does not corrode or rust. Although it is very durable, this type of steel can get scratched and stained. This is why you should follow some simple rules to keep your stainless steel equipment in good condition.

HOW TO CARE FOR STAINLESS STEEL (316L)









Cleaning Stainless Steel Equipment Stainless steel equipment is pretty easy to clean. Simply follow these steps:

- 1. Pour some warm water in a small bowl, and add some mild dishwashing soap.
- 2. Dip a soft, lint-free cloth in the soapy water, and then gently wipe the stainless steel equipment with the damp cloth until the piece is clean. When cleaning it, rub the item along its polish lines.
- 3. Wipe the remaining soap using a moist cloth dipped in clean water.
- $4.\ \mbox{Dry}$ well with a clean towel, and then leave your pieces to air dry.

After your stainless steel equipment is clean, you can use a jewelry polish or a polishing cloth to shine it. Some people use toothpaste to clean the especially dirty spots of their stainless steel pieces. Keep in mind, however, that toothpaste is abrasive. If you decide to use it for cleaning, make sure it is a non-whitening brand that does not contain silica, and use a soft cloth to rub the paste onto your pieces. Don't forget to rinse your equipment thoroughly after you are done. An alternative to these cleaning methods is to purchase a stainless steel cleaner from our store and follow the instructions on the package. You can also buy a regular jewelry cleaner whose label says that it can be used on stainless steel. Although stainless steel equipment doesn't tarnish or corrode and doesn't require special care, it can scratch.

That's why you should store your pieces in a way that minimizes any contact with other items that can damage your stainless steel equipment. If your equipment does get scratched, you can always have it professionally polished.



CHARACTERISTICS

Wood can absorb water as a liquid, if in contact with it, or as vapour from the surrounding atmosphere. Although wood can absorb other liquids and gases, water is the most important. Because of its hygroscopicity, wood, either as a part of the living tree or as a piece of our equipment, always contains moisture. Moisture affects all wood properties, and since sweat is moisture exuded through the pores of your skin, you should always remember to keep your product clear of sweat.

HOW TO CARE FOR WOODEN?









When cleaning wood equipment, never use all-purpose cleaning sprays, such as the kind used on kitchen tables. You'll usually want to avoid cleaning wood with water as well. However, extremally sticky spots may need to be treated with soap and water. To do this, dip



a lint-free cloth in mild soap or detergent dissolved in water, wring the cloth nearly dry, and wipe the area. Rinse and immediately dry with a clean, soft cloth. Oil polishes, cleaners, and furniture oils protect wood by making the surface more slippery and they do not offer a hard protective layer. Most commercial spray and liquid wood polishes contain silicone oil, which can provide some protection.



1. To revive grimy wood furniture, mix equal parts olive oil, denatured alcohol, gum turpentine, and strained lemon juice.

2. Apply with a soft cloth and buff with a clean cloth Even the highest-quality wood equipment can be susceptible to odors

Avoid polishing wood with pure olive oil, which smears and attracts dust. Instead, try this homemade recipe for cleaning wood.

Luckily, there are a few easy ways to care for your wood equipment. If a piece has a lingering smell, air it outside on a warm, dry day. Shade from direct sunlight. Pour talcum powder or baking soda over the surface to absorb odors.
